Information & Rules

Check in starts at the Ireland Sportsman Club at 11:00am

“Best Team Theme” Judging at 12:15pm

Team Captain Meeting at 12:45pm | Road Bowling immediately following

Here's how we roll:

Each team consists of 4 players* in 3 Divisions: Men's, Women's, and Co-ed: (2 Men/2 Women)

* (No one under 21 is permitted to enter—if in question, bring ID)

Prizes will be awarded at the end of the tournament as follows:

- 3 prizes in Each Division
- “Best Theme” Teams
- Ties will be determined by Sham-Rock/Paper/Scissors

Irish Road Bowling is lots of fun and easy to learn—a great way to have some fun and get some exercise

Irish Road Bowling is NOT a race—go for accuracy and distance, not speed

The rules are simple

- “Bow!” a small cannonball as far as you can down a country road.
- Scoring is on the honor system—about like keeping score for golf.
- The 4 team members rotate turns—hurling the ball down the road as far as they can.
- The throw is done underhanded—similar to bowling.
- Team-mates are 20–30 yards down the road—watching where their team's ball stops.
- Sometimes the hardest part of the game is finding the lost ball, misguided balls can sometimes end up in ditches, cornfields, creeks, etc.
- Every player MUST wear tennis shoes—For your safety, sandals and flip-flops will not be permitted.
- “Playing through” is allowed—Please be respectful of the other teams.
- For Safety Reasons—“Lofting” of balls is not allowed.
- How do you win?—The team with the fewest number of “rolls” at the end of the course wins.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Entry Fee includes—food and music.
- Your \$20 ball deposit will be refunded at the end of the course when your ball is returned.
- Parking and Check In time starts at 11:00am at the Ireland Sportsman Club—Players ONLY and their coolers will be transported to the starting point. The bowling course is closed to through traffic.
- Bring your own beverages for the day—No motorized vehicles are permitted on the course, but pull wagons & coolers with wheels are allowed. —NO LITTERING!
- There will be absolutely NO Drinking allowed on the Transportation Vehicles!!! If not adhered to you will forfeit play and be asked to leave.
- There will be port-a-potties along the course—Please use them!
